INDOOR PLANT CARE CARD

Aglaonema 'Silver Queen' (Chinese Evergreen)



A timeless indoor plant prized for its elegant silver-patterned foliage and easy-care nature

LIGHT

Can thrive in low to moderate light.
Bright, indirect light brings out the best leaf colour.
Avoid direct sun; it can scorch the leaves.

WATER

Water when the top 2cm of soil feels dry.
Let excess water drain away.
Never allow the pot to sit in water.
Too much water is the biggest mistake.

SOIL

Use a well-draining indoor plant mix.
A mix with peat, perlite, or bark works well.
Always plant in a pot with drainage holes.

FEEDING

Feed with a balanced liquid fertiliser.
Every 4–6 weeks in spring & summer.
Use half strength.
Pause feeding in autumn & winter.

COMMON PROBLEMS

Yellowing leaves?
Likely too much water.
Pests (mealybugs or spider mites)?
Treat early with neem oil.
Dull foliage?
Try slightly brighter light.

EXTRA TIPS

Wipe leaves gently with a damp cloth to remove dust.
Known for helping freshen indoor air.
A great choice for low-light rooms and busy households.
