INDOOR PLANT CARE CARD

Anthurium

(Flamingo Flower)



A striking indoor plant known for its glossy leaves and long-lasting, heart-shaped blooms



LIGHT

Thrives in bright, filtered light.
More light = more flowers.
Avoid direct sun to prevent leaf scorch.
If your Anthurium isn't blooming, try a brighter spot.

WATER

Water when the top $\frac{1}{4}$ of soil feels dry.
Keep soil moist but not wet.
Let excess water drain completely.
Enjoys humidity; mist the leaves or use a pebble tray.
Too much water leads to limp leaves.

SOIL

Use a coarse, well-draining mix.
Orchid mix plus sand and peat works well.
Never allow roots to sit in soggy soil.
Good drainage is essential.

FEEDING

Fertilise only in spring & summer.
Use a phosphorus-rich liquid fertiliser.
Apply every 4–6 weeks at $\frac{1}{4}$ strength.

COMMON PROBLEMS

Slumped leaves? Too much water.
Poor flowering? Not enough light.
Lots of water spots? Water may be sitting too long.

EXTRA TIPS

Anthuriums add a tropical feel and long-lasting blooms to indoor spaces.
Wipe leaves occasionally to keep them dust-free.
Great choice if you love regular splashes of colour.
