INDOOR PLANT CARE CARD

Zantedeschia

(Arum Lily)



A refined flowering plant admired for its elegant, sculptural blooms and glossy foliage

LIGHT

Prefers bright, indirect light.
Avoid strong direct sunlight. It can scorch leaves and blooms
A bright spot near a window with filtered sun is ideal.
Bright light encourages strong stems and abundant flowers.

WATER

Keep soil evenly moist while flowering.
Water when the top 1-2 cm feels dry.
Allow excess water to drain fully.
Reduce watering after flowering or during natural rest periods.
Calla Lilies like moisture, but not soggy soil.

SOIL

Use a well-draining, fertile potting mix.
Mixes with compost and perlite help both moisture retention and drainage.
Ensure the pot has good drainage holes.

FEEDING

Feed with a balanced, water-soluble fertiliser every 3-4 weeks during active growth and flowering.
Use at half strength.
Stop feeding as the plant enters dormancy.

COMMON PROBLEMS

Wilting or drooping: May be underwatered. Check soil moisture and water gently.
Yellowing foliage: Too much water. Allow the top soil to dry slightly.
Poor flowering: Not enough light.

EXTRA TIPS

Zantedeschia blooms are elegant and long-lasting, making them a favourite for indoor colour. After flowering, the plant may go into a resting phase. Reducing water helps it reset before the next growing cycle.
